

## *Author Lisa Reinicke School Visit Itinerary*

We know you are busy, and we want to respect your time! Please read through our itinerary, to get a better idea of the schedule for the day Lisa comes to promote reading at your school.

### Before we come

Play around on Lisa's website! Get the kids involved by letting them read her blogs, book bubbles, and pick out some fun stuff activities.

Cross promote Lisa's books in your specials. IE- In art they could make a craft from Lisa's website.

We will send you posters to hang up around the school! Have students decorate their classroom doors and/or desks with themes they learn from reading the blogs and bubbles!

### Set Up

We will arrive at your school 30 minutes prior to our first reading.

Our setup takes 10-15 minutes.

This works best in smaller groups, by grade.

3- 30 minute intervals, with a 5 minute passing period.

Typically we suggest pairing the grades as follows:

K-1st

2nd-3rd

4th-6th

We've found that the gym, or the library (if you have the space) are good locations.

We suggest placing the students in rows, it helps the flow.

(If you have another idea or suggestion, we are happy to accommodate what works best for your school.)

### The Reading



Once the students are seated, Lisa will take over. She will ask a few questions and do a little activity with the kids, that relate to the message of the book. She will read the book, and then wrap up with discussion about the book.

The book she reads depends on the age group, and the overall feel of the groups she's reading to. Each of her books has a message about values and/or morals that she touches on, as well as the writing process and some vocabulary.

\*Arnold the cute little pig with personality- This book is meant for the younger grades. She will talk about healthy eating and exercise, along with some vocabulary words.

\*Bart's Escape out the Gate- This book is great for all grades. She will talk about responsibility for caring for a pet, and having some class as a person, along with some poetry, and the general writing and illustrating process (again, depending on the age group she will adjust this to meet their levels).

\*David's Christmas Wish- Another one that is great for all grades. In this book, Lisa will talk about the importance of small gifts. She will also discuss the writing process.

\*Wings and Feet- This book is for grades 2nd-6th. This is a Mom's Choice Award Winner, and It's jam packed full of messages, and Lisa will touch on several of them! It encompasses what it means to be accepting of others despite their differences, friendship, having a voice, and the lifespan of a butterfly.

#### What do you need to do?

We like for you to decide the day and time Lisa will come. You know your schedules better than we do, so we leave that up to you!

We will need a table, approx 6ft long.

Send order forms home with students, 1 week prior to Lisa's visit. We would like to collect the order forms on the day Lisa comes, and we will fulfill all orders the day of Lisa's visit.

Any type of marketing you can help with, will make this more successful for your school. Send it out in your newsletter, pair her visit with another event you have going on at your school, etc.

#### What will Lisa Reinicke do?

Lisa will inspire your students! She has a passion for writing. She has a passion for children, teaching them those small but important lessons. Lisa will promote and encourage her anti-bullying campaign.

Lisa will personally sign each book purchased.



### The Fee
